We anticipate His return each year in keeping the Feasts of the Lord.

DATES & LOCATION:

October 11-20, 2022

- Gates will open for set up at 10am on October 11. No early arrivals.
- First HIGH SABBATH begins at sunset, Oct. 11 thru sunset on Oct. 12.
- WEEKLY SABBATH begins at sunset on Oct. 14 thru sunset Oct. 15
- Second HIGH SABBATH begins at sunset Oct. 18 thru sunset Oct. 19
- All campers must be packed up and cleared out of camp by 1pm on October 20.

We want to honor the Sabbath and ask that there is no set-up or tear down during the weekly or High Sabbaths. We are hosting our event at Red Rock Canyon Adventure Park in Hinton, OK.

REGISTRATION INFO

Total Cost of registration figures in your family size and camping needs. An "Individual" is considered 1 person attending. A "Family" is two or more members attending together.

We offer three ways to register for our event:

FULL TIME CAMPING (on-site)

The full time registration is from Oct. 11-20. This option is for those who intend to set up a tent or camper on site and remain the full length of the event. Registration includes your campsite, one evening meal (opening night), all workshops and programs.

- RV: Each RV site has electric and water.
 There are limited sites available and will be given on a first come, first served basis. Sites are assigned based on need and the size of your RV. You will receive your campsite at arrival. Please coordinate rental RVs with Amanda Meyer at Amanda@grafted.faith
- PRIMITIVE: Tent campsites do not have electric or water but access to water is available around the campground.
 Guests using tents may have a total of 2 tents and 1 shade tent per site.

FULL TIME OFFSITE ACCOMODATIONS

This registration is for those who intend to make other lodging arrangements and attend daily programs the full time of the event.

Registration includes one evening meal (opening night), all workshops and programs.

DAYPASS (non-camping)

Day Pass is for those who would like to attend as their schedule allows. Day Pass rates are paid per day. No day passes will be issues on the elected free days Fri. Oct. 14 or Mon. Oct. 17.

DAYPASS (rate per day): Payment, in full, is due at registration.

Balances are due by: October 1

Refunds: If you need to cancel your registration prior to the event, please let us know by September 27. Registration, minus the \$50 deposit, will be refundable. After September 27, refunds will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

If you need to leave in the middle of the Feast, or if you are asked to leave by the Director, refunds may be forfeited to cover reserved camping fees. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis, within 60 days of closing camp.



RED ROCK CANYON PARK RULES

- DO NOT FEED WILDLIFE: Observe, but do not disturb the wildlife. If you have an animal that needs to be removed, please call camp services.
- DEFACING PROPERTY IS PROHIBITTED
- FIREWORKS ARE PROHIBITTED AND CAN RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE CAMPGROUND
- HUNTING IS PROHIBITTED
- CAMPFIRES MUST BE IN RINGS. **During burn** bans, campfires will be prohibited.
- WATCH YOUR CAMPFIRE. Do not leave a fire unattended.
- PICKING WILDFLOWERS IS PROHIBITTED
- CUTTING BRANCHES IS PROHIBITTED
- DUMPING WASTE WATER IS PROHIBITTED
- PETS MUST BE ON A 10ft (max) LEASH AT ALL TIMES.

GRAFTED GUIDELINES

Sukkot is the season of our JOY. This is a feast where we are commanded to be JOYFUL. Please leave all contentions and strife outside the campgrounds. We encourage everyone to refrain from complaining, arguing, poor attitudes and division.

<u>SECURITY TEAM:</u> This team is created to look out for us and ensure that children and campers are safe, as well as no unregistered guests are loitering in our camping areas.

<u>FAMILIES</u>: Parents, you are responsible for your children/minors. Please be aware of your children's whereabouts at all times. The wooded areas and creek are off limits. No one under 18 years old is allowed on the trails without an adult.

<u>PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (PDA):</u> Teens should not be showing any PDA during Sukkot and are expected to keep their hands to themselves.

<u>CURFEW & QUIET HOURS:</u> All minors, under 18 years old, must be at their campsites or with their parents by 10pm each evening. Please refrain from loud noises between the hours of 10pm and 7am.

RESPECT PRIVACY: Please be aware of boundaries. Children should not enter someone else's' tent or RV, take any camping gear, or meander through campsites without permission.

<u>DRESS CODE:</u> Please keep shorts/skirts knee length or longer. Avoid skintight attire. All tank tops should cover bras (including straps).

FOOD ALLERGIES: We have guests with SERIOUS nut allergies. Please keep all nuts confined to your camping areas and do not add to potluck dishes. Please do not share snacks without parental consent!

<u>DRUGS & ALCOHOL:</u> NO GLASS containers. Please keep drinking refined to personal campfires. Recreational use of illegal or medical drugs will not be accepted. If you bring any THC product you will be asked to show proof of a medical use card.

<u>3 STRIKES:</u> We will have a 3 Strike policy. 1st offence of rules or guidelines will be a warning. 2nd offence is a discussion with the Elders. 3rd offence could result in restriction of activities or removal from camp.

PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

EVENING SERVICES: We expect for all campers to attend evening services. If you are unable to attend service, please do not roam the camp during this time. All minors must be with their adults during service times.



SABBATH OBSERVANCE: We are a Sabbath keeping congregation. Please do not plan to set-up or tear down your campsite on the weekly or feast Sabbaths. Your schedule will highlight these days and we encourage guests to purchase ice, groceries and plan tasks accordingly.

ADULT WORKSHOPS: There will be various workshops thru the week. These will include specific times for men, women, Q&A and various teachings.

CHILDRENS PROGRAM: There will be two days with scheduled children's programs for ages 4-10. *Please Note: We will only be available to host this program if we have the volunteers needed to teach & supervise.

TEEN PROGRAM: We will have two designated times for teens (11-17) to gather. They will get to know each other, have lessons and play some great camp games.

BAPTISMS: We will offer baptisms on the second High Sabbath during the feast. Sign up opening night.

WEDDING VOW RENEWAL: If you would like to renew your wedding vows, you can sign up for that during the opening night of the event. Vow renewals are on the second High Sabbath

DANCE WORSHIP: Dance circles will be formed each evening at service. We ask that the dancers be 10yr old and older for the safety of the children and dancers. Only experienced dancers will be allowed to dance in the center circle. Please wear appropriate attire if you plan to be dancing (no low tops, short skirts/shorts, shoes, etc.)

DANCE OFFERINGS: If you would like to perform a special dance offering during an evening service, please see Ann Stropes.

FREE DAYS: We have planned two free days thru the week. These days will have limited programming and will be open for families to catch up on laundry, shopping, relax, or just fellowship.

MARKETPLACE: If you have a product you would like to sell, Marketplace will be the on a free day between 10am-2pm at individual campsites. Your product could be essential oils, tzit-tzit, tees, homemade soaps, etc. You will be responsible for any supplies you need to set up your market.

FELLOWSHIP MEAL & TALENT OFFERING: There will be a Fellowship Potluck at the large pavilion on the second free day. Please plan to bring a **large** dish to share and enjoy a meal together. If you would like to offer a talent during this fellowship, *please contact Amber Thornbrough*. Talents include singing, instrumentals, dance, or a funny (and appropriate) joke. NOTE: there will be limited stage space and sound system. Slots are limited and talent Screening will occur prior to the event.







AREAS OF VOLUNTEER SERVICE

All campers, 13 years and older, are expected to volunteer and serve periodically. Team leads have been selected for the following areas and may contact volunteers prior to our feast dates.

AREAS OF SERVICE

FACILITY MONITORS: These folks are VIP and a MUST at the campground. This team will check trashcans, bathroom supplies and camp cleanliness throughout the week. A sweep and spray down of bathrooms may be required.

CHILDREN & YOUTH PROGRAMS: If you have a child who is attending the program, please try to volunteer for a class. Volunteers may be teaching or supporting the main teachers and assisting as needed with games, crafts, etc.

COFFEE KEEPERS: These folks will be helping to monitor the coffee house. We need to stay on top of coffee pots through the week. A constant carafe of coffee should be available. Supplies will be provided for you.

WATCHMEN: Our safety and security team <u>must be 21 years old</u> or older. We need volunteers to sign up for 4 hours shifts that will include patrolling the campgrounds (LOTS OF WALKING), keeping children safe, and attend to any emergency that arises. Teens may sign up as Jr. Watchmen and shadow and adult during their shift.

MEDICAL: Volunteers <u>MUST be licensed for medical care</u> (EMT, CPN, RN, LPN, etc.). There will be a rotation of volunteers that will tend to emergency medical needs.

FIREWOOD: We will have some firewood available for purchase, as well as the Red Rock Canyon Office will have wood for sale.

We will not have an official community kitchen, however the community fire will be available for grill grates to be used.
