- PARENTS: You are responsible for your children/minors. Please be aware of their whereabouts at all times. If your child has repeated offenses that require staff intervention, they may be asked to stay with you for the remainder of the event. If issues persist, you may be asked to leave the event.
- <u>DRESS CODE</u>: Keep shorts and skirts knee length and avoid clothing that is tight. Please do not wear tees with inappropriate language or images. Ladies, please do not wear low cut tops that droop or tanks with low cut underarms without appropriate coverage. Gentlemen please do not wear tank tops.

Appropriate clothing would be: no short dresses/skirts/shorts and no low cut tops. *Dance is an element of our worship service and offering to YHWH, all* dancers are expected to exhibit respectful and reverent behavior while dancing, which includes reverence during prayer and no excessive discussions outside of those for the purpose of dance instruction. *Note to younger dancers: Instruction will be given to you by the dance lead. No horse playing or trying to trip/push each other or you will be removed from the dance circle.*
